

Word of Command for New Members Assessment Scheme 2012

The squad is fall in by trainer.

Squad is properly dressed by trainer.

*First candidate fall out with a right turn, march toward the commander from the left hand side of the trainer commander.

Commander make a left turn to the candidate waiting candidate arrive.

Candidate halts, salutes and reports.

Candidate: "Good morning/afternoon Sir. Recruit _____ report for commanding examination, Sir"

Trainer: "Carry on"

Commander "Thank you Sir"

Candidate salutes to trainer, marches and halts at the commander's position. Left turn, face toward to squad.

(Squad automatically blanks file. Blank file won't account for commanding, but for individual footdrill performance.)

Standard commanding sequence

(4 marks each)

1. Stand at **EASE**.
2. Atten**TION**.
3. Squad Right **DRESS**.
4. Eyes **FRONT**.
5. Move to the right, right **TURN**.
6. Move to the left, about **TURN**.
7. Into line, left **TURN**.
8. Into Line, about **TURN**.
9. Move to the right, right **TURN**.
10. By the left, quick **MARCH**.
11. Squad **HALT**.
12. Move to the left, about **TURN**.
13. By the right quick **MARCH**.
14. Squad **HALT**.
15. Into line, right **TURN**.
16. Squad right **DRESS**
17. Eyes **FRONT**.

Candidate commander about turn, march to trainer and salute.

Candidate: "Examination completed, any other instruction sir?"

Trainer: "No. Carry on."

Candidate: "Thank you sir."

Candidate march back into the squad. Next candidate start the procedure from the asterisk above.
